BEST PRACTICES FOR REMOTE LEARNING

- Be on time for your meet. Your teacher will take attendance at the start of class, so in order to be marked "present" you must be on time. The first minutes are very important; your teacher will go over directions and assignments at the start of class.
- Be on camera and participate in class discussions.
 Again, in order to be counted as "present" you must be visible in the meet.
- 3. Although you're not physically at school, you should treat the space as your classroom. That means out of bed, dressed for school.
- 4. Turn your work in on time. You will still be graded on the work your teachers assign, so be sure to keep track of when your assignments are due.
- 5. Reach out to teachers, counselors, principals, or any school personnel when you have questions. We're here to support you!
